- 1. Please check grammar and spelling errors.
- 2. Please rephrase the sentences in passive voice.
- 3. The abstract has not been written adequately and should be modified significantly. Indeed, the abstract should reflect the overall content of the paper. Hence, the authors should rewrite the abstract, not to detail it, but to focus on the outlines and the tasks in the paper without going into details.
- 4. Highlight the novelty and contribution of the paper in the introduction.
- 5. The authors need to mention briefly, with application of the present work in the real world, what is new in this problem and why it is considered?
- 6. What are the key features of the proposed techniques? (Properties, characteristics, and weaknesses).
- 7. The significance of the obtained results should be highlighted.
- 8. Please add more figures or tables to elaborate your results.
- 9. Compare the results of locating domination and roman domination of the graphs. What is the need to use this new concept? In which graph should this concept be preferred?
- 10. There is no conclusion section in the paper. The authors should add more information about future directions in the conclusion section.

In short, the results of the paper are satisfactory. After correction along the above lines, the paper may be recommended for publication.
