The mini-review is interesting, but I missed more data about the foodborne RNA viruses on the continents, especially if the title uses the word "global." The way that information was presented is lacking this kind of information. Also, as the article mentions that these diseases are correlated with socio-economic issues, it could be better sustained with some data from continents or countries. It presents information about the transmission routes, but it could be more deeply detailed, describing how the food gets contaminated along the food supply chain, for example, conservation temperature problems, how humans contaminate the food (by coughing on it, by handling the food after going to the bathroom without washing their hands, etc).

This theme is very important, so congratulations on the idea, and I believe that if you deepen some data as suggested, it will get even more interesting.
