

Review of: "The Support and Rehabilitation of Refugees – Personal Opinion and Experience"

I commend the author in his work with refugees. I find it difficult to evaluate this article because it is not clear its purpose if the author wants to publish it in a journal (that was my impression when I accepted the review) or in a magazine.

Depending on the target, the structure of the article would be very different. However, I can recommend the author to focus on the main objective of the article, introduce the topic with a much shorter poem and then, in your own words, what you want to tell readers and why you think it is important. I am not sure the division of the article according to countries really works. Also, the article should not be written taking for granted a UK based readership. Please correct this aspect if this is not your objective. For example you mention "here" instead of UK. Define abbreviations such as PTSD, and even NHS (related to previous point). The contents in the last section should be presented at the beginning of the article for clarity and context and your experience should illustrate your points. The very last sentences are a bit confusing referring to "I" and "we", and therefore it is not clear if the article is trying to recruit volunteers or advocating for involvement in supporting a cause. Again, with more information on the author's intention I would be able to provide a better review.
