

Review of: "The Learning of Interpersonal Sexuality Among Young French Adults Under the Prism of Consent"

The work is well written. I would like to provide my comments below.

- 1. Abstract: It is well written. No comments on it.
- 2. Introduction: In the first paragraph, there has been mention of the availability of misinformation and pornographic content among adolescents. Can you provide specific examples of how quantitative data on misinformation and pornography could enhance the introduction?
- 3. Methods: The population sample taken was of the age group 23-28 years, with a mix of young adults from 7 women, 6 men, and 1 non-binary person. Are the numbers enough to reach data saturation to fulfil the goals the study is trying to achieve, especially with only one young adult who identifies as non-binary? Could you specify how the inclusion of more non-binary participants might impact the study's findings and conclusions? Also, were there any specific software used to analyze the data?
- 4. Results: I have no comment on this segment.
- 5. Discussions: It is well written and takes into account literature from a long time frame.

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
