- Some other studies in a larger scale in Ethiopia have been done to assess the immunization uptake and factors
  determining it. The author needs to write a stronger argument on why there is a need to conduct the study in a specific
  area with limited number of participants by perhaps informing how this specific area differed from other areas in
  Ethiopia.
- 2. Vaccination status and people behavior in vaccination may be influenced by a wide range of factors, including the factors from personal characteristics, community, social norms, and also factors from the health system. This article concerns only the factors of personal characteristics of the respondents. This needs to be explained.
- 3. The discussion is also limited, need to add more about study implication.
