The clarity and presentation of the figures and tables are sufficient for proper data collection. The strengths and weaknesses of the methodology used in the study are a good title and introductory section, and data presentations, and the weaknesses of the study include the following, as mentioned by the authors: its retrospective nature, reliance on electronic health record data, and potential confounding factors not accounted for in the analysis. Additionally, the definition of long COVID-19 and the criteria for identifying vaccinated individuals may introduce bias and variability in the results. My recommendation is acceptance of the article for publication after minor revision.
