- 3.In this empirical work, the researchers have found that in some sample regions, labour unrest is more. Did the researchers try to find any reasons for such results?

Addressing the above points may improve the quality of the paper. However, this is a nice attempt by all the authors involved in this study. Publication of the paper will add valuable insights into the existing literature on labour unrest.
