- The problem statement stresses the need to investigate specific organizational factors influencing the intrapreneurial behavior of Malaysian academicians. To improve clarity, clearly define and scope these factors, emphasizing the critical research gap's importance for academia and organizational development. Integrate findings from Norhasimah and Ismail (2012), Ismail et al. (2012), and Voo et al. (2019) to highlight unexplored aspects. Provide a concise rationale for selecting academicians from four public universities in the Southern region of Malaysia, underscoring their relevance. Strengthen the justification for including gender, emphasizing its essential role in understanding intrapreneurial behavior comprehensively.
- In addition to reporting the results, the manuscript would benefit from a more insightful discussion section. This could
 involve offering explanations for the findings, comparing results with previous studies, and providing a cautious
 interpretation of the results. This would enhance the overall depth and contribution of the article, e.g., The role of
 entrepreneurial leadership within university top management, as discussed by Abd Rahim et al. (2023; 2022), could
 add a valuable dimension to the study.
- The theoretical implications could be further developed in relation to RBV. Expanding on this aspect would contribute to the broader academic discourse and provide additional value to the readers.
- Consider removing the term 'chapter' when referencing the thesis in the text to align with the standard format of a
 research article.
