I appreciate the authors' work, which I find interesting and beneficial for understanding transcendent experiences and spirituality in general.

I would have only one comment about this study, and that is to show in the table the similarities and differences in the descriptions of people who had an NDE experience and the descriptions of God in the sacred books.

On the formal side, I would recommend expanding the conclusion.

These investigations should be continued, and in the future I would suggest investigating NDEs outside the USA as well (this is mentioned by the authors as a limitation of the research) and distinguishing groups into believers and non-believers. In this context, I would be interested in what the statements of non-believers will be and whether language and, in fact, the entire socio-cultural experience of a person has an influence on these experiences.

As a reviewer, I recommend the work for publication after completing one more table.
