

Review of: "Weathering changes – livelihood adaptation to weather shocks in rural India by disadvantaged social groups"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

This is an interesting study that is able to link meteorological data with social behaviour, thereby helping understanding adaptation in social groups. The text needs some curation, though.

Detailed comments:

at "mortality. Burgess et al. (2017) using" there should be a comma before "using"

SCs and STs should be explained the first time they are used as abbreviations, or should be included when the whole term is firstly used in the paper

"Sedova and Kalkuhl (2020)using" - insert space

"our first research question examines whether does slow-onset climate change lead to migration in rural India?" - that sentence requires grammar revision

"So, we also examine whether disadvantaged social groups also take part in such migration?" - I don't think there should a quotation mark there, and same with the other two questions at the end of the two following paragraphs

For the moisture index, it would be more adequate to use the word "humid", not "wet". Same with "wetness" and "humidity"

"While the decennial censuss captures migration" correct with "census"
