Milligrams per deciliter; a unit of measure that shows the concentration of a substance in a specific amount of fluid. In the United States, *blood glucose* test results are reported as mg/dL. Medical journals and other countries use millimoles per liter (*mmol/L*). To convert

to mg/dL from mmol/L, multiply mmol/L by 18. Example: 10 mmol/L \times 18 = 180 mg/dL.
