- 2. For "Figure 2. Four pillars of sustainability," please put the reference (Otherwise "own analysis").
- 3. For "Figure 5.VosViewer keyword concurrence found in the selected literature," why is the label on the big blue dot disappeared?
- 4. For "**Figure 6.** Overall SDGs found in the papers," it is better to rearrange SDGs in the boxes by order (e.g., from SDG 1 to 17) for better readability.
- 5. What is the contribution of this paper to further development, especially with other stakeholders?

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
