The abstract needs to be structure as Introduction, problem statement, methodology, results and significance of the paper. From the abstract the methodology seems not details, the results not quantify with figures/percentages and the significance of the paper not specified.

Methodology

The authors should have structure the section as method and material. This would have accommodated Table 4.1. Nigeria and UK energy consumption per capita (KWh) 2000-2020. The results section ought to be more of reported outcomes rather than data presentation.

Conclusions

"The policy implications of this study include the need for policymakers in Nigeria to focus on formulating and conscientiously implementing policies that will ensure adequate energy supply while tackling other problems in the sector."

Going by this statement, the authors have not provided a policy guidelines/ framework that needs to be adopted by Nigeria from the UK for adoption/ improvement in addressing their power sectors challenges.

Conclusively, the paper looks more of reporting on the information that is available, a contribution to knowledge needs to come out clear on the policies adoption by Nigeria energy sector as a learning point from UK energy sector. Basing the paper on the descriptive analysis without giving the policies framework / adoption does not show inn

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
