- 2. In page no.5 rewrite the sentence "They also point out. The importance of critical evaluation and application of climate-related information is emphasized, as simply acquiring knowledge is not enough" as it is grammatically not correct.
- 3. In page no.6 subsection C and D headings are same. Check the headings and make necessary changes.
- 4. Summaries the section II before starting section III.
- 5. Quality of figure.2 is not good. Image is not clearly visible.
- 6. What is Expert Choice software (AHP method). Expand or explain AHP method.
- 7. Rewrite the sentences "The final action is to stay informed by following local news and staying in touch with the Global Goals on social media or online, with the handle @TheGlobalGoals." Make it grammatically correct by making necessary corrections.
- 8. Rewrite the sentences "The discussion on values should be comprehensive, at least from the point of view of human dignity and equality: should everyone, for example, have the same opportunities for success and prosperity, and if so, why are we depriving each other?" as it is grammatically incorrect.
- 9. Subsection C and D are not properly explained. Same sentences are written in the both the sections C and D. References 29-32 are cited more than once.
- 10. Subsections are not clearly explained.

Summary of the article is not clear. There are so many grammatical errors in the article.
