However, I have a few suggestions for the authors to incorporate in the revision to improve the presentation of their work. My suggestions are as follows:

1. The abstract can be improved by providing sufficient details to strengthen their claims like "the proposed system is more viable than the Romanization...", how this model is more viable, please provide logical reasoning?
2. Similarly, the author stated in the Abstract section that "The obtained results are helpful...", how these are helpful? Please provide proof with a numerical analysis and perform some validations to strengthen your claim. Moreover, this practice must be followed in the Abstract and Conclusion section of the paper.
3. For the readers' point of view, it will be more encouraging to define a bulleted list in the Introduction section, where the authors may define the main objectives of their work. This was the readers will get an easier insight of this research work.
4. Some references are from 1960 and even 1990s, while no references from 2021, 2022. Why this is so (whether there is no work on this domain, or your work is outdated as this is 2023 now) so, please include some recent references and compare your work with these references.
5. In the Introduction section, the authors stated that "In this article, we will consider...", why we will, this is thesis work that you will do in near future? Please explain.
6. There are many grammatical and typos mistakes, please follow an expert or a third party to improve the overall English of the draft.
