Although the author tries to take a conceptual approach from the middle to the end of the text, he gets lost in the format of presenting these concepts. No matter how nice and clean figures the author gives the reader, the paper does not present essential concepts with greater depth. It is limited to quoting them in an inaccessible but less formal language without literature references, not contributing to the methodological rigor required for a scientific paper. I think the work should have a better structure, and the author should broaden his base of literature references, delving deeper into the concepts presented. It is also necessary to structure the text-writing stages better to present the work as a scientific paper. I think the work does not make any scientific contribution in its current format.
