Review of: "Trust and Trade: Patient Perspectives on the Ethics of Real-World Data Monetisation"

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This commentary is a well-written, concise, and thought-provoking piece. It sheds light on the issue of trust in data reuse and provides a concrete framework, articulated through five dimensions, for bringing moral legitimacy into practice by adapting existing processes, such as consent, to be trust-enhancing.
