This is a basic uncontrolled observational study. Unfortunately, the authors do not share data necessary to determine any significance to their observations. Although the correlated factors are intuitive, the complexity of risk and vulnerability to threats is complex and requires a far more detailed assessment than the author's describe in this article. This review suggests a more detailed reporting of the data collected with its significance and then recommendations for subsequent study for architectural design security recommendations to have validity. Additionally, although appreciation of healthcare provider sense of safety and security is an important metric to assess, it has high variability and is not predictive of effects of security measure implementation.
