This paper is relatively simple (from the point of view of Mathematical Logic), thus readable. It is rigorous and well organised. I would suggest to quantify "non-locality," which, as far as I can understand, is "just" a matter of length of sequences. That is, I suggest to give some numerical estimation of the computational limits presented in the paper - it would greatly help (as a matter of fact, non-locality, even if meant to be a gergon, recalls a too ambitious reference to "quantum non-locality").
