This is a very interesting topic and a well thought study certainly worth publishing. The paper would benefit, however, from a more thorough writing, e.g. the community still prefers the aesthetics of a single paragraph abstract and, I think, a more fluid narrative.

Introduction:

I would strongly recommend to include more empirical literature on NDEs, as well as a revision of the main sceptical arguments.

Second paragraph: I think it is not necessary to name any mystics.

Fourth: "the awareness of self-awareness"?

Method:

"Data set", instead of "Data searching"

The final "Comment" in this section is very exciting. I (and I presume many readers too) would have liked to hear more.

Discussion:

I find the authors points very interesting. However, I think they miss the chance to also discuss their findings in contrast to some of the main sceptical arguments which, as I indicate above, could be incorporated to the literature review.
