- 2. In Table 1, I see only 8 patients' data? This is a very small and nuclear data which is not sufficient for scientific consideration as all the 8 doesn't belong to the same age group. Can you provide any statistical data or justify.
- 3. At the same time, in Table 1, what is the total "n" considered for each age group? Or is this a generalized or random data? Please explain.
- 4. Table 1 show that the work is done more on female patients compared to that on male patients. Can you please explain the reason? If this is not a work, is this just a single report?
- 5. What does manifest and not manifest in Table 1 mean? Please, mention
- 6. The Table 1 reports the levels of ACTH and Cortisol. How did you measure them?
- 7. In Table 1, what do you mean by good/bad prognosis? You must explain your opinion or consideration in this regard

Minor suggestion: You must consider revising your English language with an English expert or English speaking person.
