2. There was no need for a separate section as Background. The information could fit into the Introduction section very well.
3. The writing seemed more informative than analytical, which is fine for an Introduction.
4. Please take care of grammatical errors. They were found throughout the text.
5. The methodology was unclear. Please rewrite – What is the sample size? Is there a field site? Any gender and age details? What kind of methodology is used? Is it empirical or is it based on secondary data?
6. Overall, the findings section seems more informative than analytical. Rather than putting them in points, it would be nice if the authors could analyze how and why...
7. The article ended abruptly. A conclusion section needs to be introduced.
