The authors have shared a good a point of view about the possible benefits of cupping therapy (CT) in COVID-19 by summarizing current available evidence of CT for some common symptoms and signs, including fever, dry cough and respiratory problem and shortness of breath, and lymphopenia.

The underlying rationales are not direct data or evidence of CT for COVID-19, therefore, it is less convincing. Besides, the manuscript seems to be too simple, e.g. no inclusion and exclusion criteria, no quality assessment, etc. All these limits the impact of this paper.
