• Since there is cotton in the title, it is recommended that the Latin word for cotton may be sufficient in the keywords.

- In all numerical expressions , or . should be used and uniformity throughout the article is recommended.
- It is recommended to correct the spelling of CO2 and N2O throughout the article. (CQ and N₂O)
- Figure 1a has a figure caption both above and below. It is recommended to delete the top title.
- In the explanation of the abbreviations in Table 6, it is not explained what the expression F means.
- A description of Table 7 is included both above and within the table. It is recommended to remove the contents.
- Although doi is found in many sources, it has not been written. It is recommended to complete missing doi's.
- FAO215 is written in the article, it is recommended to correct it as FAO2015.

• It is recommended to correct the expression Poore et al., 2018, in the article as Poore and Nemecek, 2018.

• Mbow et. al, Weibin et al. In some sources, such as, it is forgotten to specify the year in the sources section. It is recommended to check the sources.

• It is not included in the sources in the article (European Commission 2018).

• It is recommended to correct reference references such as Marseni T. et al., 2010, Pishgar-Komleh S. et al., 2012 in the article, such as Marseni et al., 2010, Pishgar-Komleh et al., 2012. It is recommended to check all such notations in the article.

• For example, one source is written as "Oertel Cornelius, Matschullat Jörg, Zurba Kamal, Zimmermann Frank, Erasmi, Stefan (2016) ..." while another source is written as "Poore, J. and Nemecek, T. (2018) ...". When editing resources, it is recommended to organize them in a single format.
