

Review of: "Ancient DNA Clarifies the Identity and Geographic Origin of the Holotype of the Genus Ctenomys"

The manuscript titled "Ancient DNA Clarifies the Identity and Geographic Origin of the Holotype of the Genus Ctenomys" is well-written. The introduction provides adequate background for the study. The authors sequenced the holotype of Ctenomys brasiliensis to determine its taxonomic identity, analyzing the mitogenome of C. brasiliensis and six closely related species. Phylogenetic analyses confirmed that C. brasiliensis is a valid species, leading to the synonymization of C. minutus. In the results section, the sentence "Phylogenetic analyses based on both mitogenome and Cyt b gene sequences recovered a strongly supported monophyletic group of Ctenomys (BS = 100; PP = 1; Fig. 3 and 4), with well-resolved relationships among the species groups generally consistent with prior studies[28]" should be avoided. This statement represents an interpretation and should be moved to the discussion section.
