

Review of: "Support for Campus Censorship"

First of all, I would like to congratulate the researchers who have carried out this study. It is an ambitious investigation that attempts to shed light on a phenomenon that is increasingly exposed in current research.

The fact that three types of variables associated with censorship are taken into account in four different types of samples is a challenge, as it presents a broad and therefore complicated study. Moreover, the addition of ideology and the study of variables associated with the different countries seems initially unfeasible, although it is subsequently manageable for the authors.

Although precisely this difficulty in handling the data is an aspect that the authors seem to handle well, I think that perhaps it would have been simpler for the reader to delve into each of these studies independently. At some points, the reading becomes complex, and at times it is necessary to go back in order not to lose the thread of the data. In this respect, the frequent presence of graphs and data tables that facilitate understanding and monitoring is appreciated.

Finally, in the same way that the limitations of the work are described, I miss the description of future lines of work based on the results obtained. Given the importance and relevance of the studies presented, it would be advisable to present future lines of work that could explore this problem in greater depth.

For the rest, it seems to me to be a very ambitious and complete work.

I hope that the recommendations contained in this review can be taken into account in the future.
