In particular, the title, hypotheses and literature findings should be reviewed. More explanatory information about the model used should be given. Firstly, the hypotheses of the study should be clearly stated and the rationale of the study should be written. Although it is a comprehensive study, the numerical and statistical data obtained are not sufficiently interpreted and discussed with the relevant literature. Although the studies carried out on this subject are given, the status and the results found especially in Morocco cannot be seen. The research seems to be complicated for the reader and when read from the beginning to the end, it is not clear what is really wanted to be achieved and what has been found. It is suggested that the study should be revised, the hypotheses should be clearly stated, the methodology should be detailed, the findings should be simplified and the results should be discussed in line with the literature. Also, what will be the actual outcome of the study? This part is very general. It is suggested to be written by adding suggestions for future researchers.
