There is a strong bias towards the land part, although it broadly covers important issues such as carrying capacity and sustainable construction. It seems to me that the part on building conservation strategies should be strengthened. Strengthen the literature review on heritage conservation in a global context and elaborate more in the conclusions, highlighting its contributions, limitations, the scientific value of the article, and its applicability for future studies.
