A population of cytotoxic T-lymphocytes (CTLs) specifically reactive to one or more preselected viruses, with potential antiviral activity. Upon infusion, after an allogeneic hematopoietic cell transplant (HCT) or in other immunodeficient states, these CTLs help reconstitute viral-specific CTL responses and kill virally infected cells, thereby inhibiting viral infection in immunocompromised patients.
