

Review of: "Studying the Level of Livelihood Vulnerability and the Necessity of the Work Developing a Farmhouse Economic Economic Model to Adapt to Climate Change in the Coastal Area of Ben Tre"

The article is interesting on the whole, even if it remains very descriptive. The bibliography should be expanded, and more recent references would also be appreciated.

I find the title far too long. I suggest a shorter title such as: "Livelihood Activities, Vulnerability, and Adaptation to Climate Change for Poor Communities: The Coastal Area of Ben Tre in Vietnam."

Concerning keywords, I suggest adding Vietnam and sustainability.

Section 3.4 is missing.

For all tables, the units in which the data are expressed must be specified.

Please note: In Table 3.4, the total is not 80 but 84 households.

In terms of methodology, it would be interesting to add socio-economic and demographic data on the 80 households surveyed. It is not known when the survey was carried out or how the sample was selected. It is important to specify how the interviews were conducted. As far as the results are concerned, you need to be more precise and avoid too many details that could confuse the reader.

The proposed solutions envisage the role of certain players such as the Women's Union, the Farmers' Union, the Youth Union, for instance, without referring to the results of the community survey... We need to argue this and show that it is part of the solution to the problem of adapting to climate change for coastal populations.

I'm not convinced by the conclusion, the content of which is disconnected from the purpose of the article... How does the contribution of the article relate to green growth? To agriculture 4.0? That seems to me to be not clear.

I invite the author to go back to the content and produce a better version of the article.
