This is a timely commentary that cautions against the overeager adoption of AI in medicine, due to longstanding concerns over the actual contextual intelligence of said AI models. In particular, various examples of AI models basing decisions on inappropriate (and often non-human-discernable and/or ridiculous to humans) features are discussed.

However, it might be somewhat negatively focused, and measures currently being taken to mitigate the shortcomings of AI models (including cooperation with humans as part of an audited screening process) might also be presented for a more balanced outlook.
