However, if I talk about the study content, it is interesting. But I have found many issues in the article and based on it I am not agree to accept this manuscript for publication in the present form:

1. Study problem is not well defined
2. Introduction is very short and no much information about biomedical waste management.
3. There need a state-of-art literature review because there are many publications on biomedical waste during the Covid-19 pandemic
4. No justification of the study discussed
5. I think only primary survey based data is not justifiable because there is a high chance of biasness.
6. There is actually no real results. The authors should consider scientific publications how to write results and study findings
7. There is also need modification of Discussion section because there is no comparison how your study is different from existing literatures
8. No construct conclusion is given.
