- 1. Study problem is not well defined
- 2. Introduction is very short and no much information about biomedical waste management.
- There need a state-of-art literature review because there are many publications on biomedical waste during the Covid-19 pandemic
- 4. No justification of the study discussed
- 5. I think only primary survey based data is not justifiable because there is a high chance of biasness.
- 6. There is actually no real results. The authors should consider scientific publications how to write results and study findings
- 7. There is also need modification of Discussion section because there is no comparison how your study is different from existing literatures
- 8. No construct conclusion is given.
