Review of: "The Imperative of a Comprehensive One Health Approach for Mosquito-Borne Disease Control in Indonesia"

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Minor issues / style improvements

Replace “single health concept” with “**One Health approach**” consistently.

Tighten repeated statements (several paragraphs restate the One Health need without adding new content).

Add a short **Methods** note: even in narrative reviews, state how you selected sources (databases, keywords, timeframe) to improve transparency.

Ensure references include **primary Indonesian MOH or surveillance reports** where possible.

High-impact additions (recommended)

Figure: One Health operational model for Indonesia (stakeholders + data flows).

Table: Disease-by-disease One Health mapping (vector, ecology, animal link, best interventions).

Box: “Immediate 6–12 month actions” vs “2–5 year system strengthening.”

Indicators dashboard: 8–12 KPIs for monitoring progress nationally.

Suggested “change...to...” edits (examples)

Change “single health approach” → “**One Health approach**”

Change “mosquito-borne disease-free Indonesia” → “measurable reduction in incidence, outbreaks, and mortality with targeted elimination goals (disease-specific)”

Add after “IVM strategies” → “including insecticide resistance surveillance and resistance management plans”
