## State-led Development and Youth Unemployment in the Arab and non-Arab Countries

The author examines the Saheli-Isfahani's projection on high youth unemployment in Arab countries in comparison to non-Arab countries. Using a set of data, he establishes that the worsening influence of state-led development on youth unemployment is not-region specific.

The paper is interesting and well written and I suggest some revisions as follows:

- 1. The work is a demonstration of a result postulated by Saheli-Isfahani (2012). What suggestions does the author make to address this rising trend of youth unemployment in these countries?
- 2. In the literature review, the authors do not refer to theoretical models of the unemployment problem. Is this a deliberate choice or such a model does not exist?
- 3. The references used by the authors are mostly old ones. For example: only one reference from 2022 and only two from 2021. We suggest that the authors densify the review with more recent references.
- 4. On page 6 and sixth line from the end, shift the subscript t-1
- 5. It is desirable that the authors recall the meaning of the ILO (International Labor Organization) the first time it is used on page 6.
