Thank you for the opportunity to review this manuscript titled "Prevalence of Buruli Ulcer among residentd in Jasikan Municipal: A cross-sectional study" for possible publication in your journal. The manuscript was a descriptive cross-sectional study which provided an overview on this neglected tropical disease in Jasikan Municipality.

The title and the abstract were adequate, and the introduction was equally adequate, however, the statistical analysis section in the methodology was scanty and confusing. The extent of the descriptive analysis was not detailed.

Similarly, on the results section, beside the frequency table and the prevalence, there was no chi square or student t test analysis comparing study participants with and without Buruli Ulcer in the results section. What was the essence of the statically significant level of 5% stated in the methods section above?

My recommendation is that the manuscript be accepted with minor revision please.
