- The article must be more solid in terms of bibliographical references more recent,
- The structure of the article is unclear,
- It is impossible to determine the methodology, the results, the discussion and the conclusion parties. The article must be well structured, while respecting the parts already mentioned, if it is to have a significant scientific impact.
- The study identifies key issues regarding environmental factors for the sustainable development and investment goals. Some specific issues should be improved.
- The description of the study context/importance of the study is relatively good, the study methods and data are clearly described, and the results are summarized in an acceptable manner.² More strategies should be given at the end of the abstract part based on the analysis results.
- The contributions of this study should be explained at the end of the introduction part in a more detailed manner.
- The contribution of the manuscript should be explained more in the conclusion.
- More information should be given about the limitations and future Research directions in the conclusion part.
- I suggest minor English language editing and avoiding long complex sentences that go apart from main idea.
- After minor revisions, the manuscript is acceptable
