

Review of: "Knowledge, Practices and Attitude of Residents towards Buruli Ulcer in Jasikan Municipality: An Ethnographic Study"

Strengths

- The topic or area is important for scientific community and to the whole community and it is interesting. Because it brings one of the debilitating NTDs.
- · The subsections and structure of the manuscript is also appropriate and well organised.
- · The methods are also clear.
- Ethical issue is addressed.
- · Issue of competing of interest is also addressed.

Weakness

- The manuscript might be questionable scientifically, because the sample size is too small and also the time each participant interviewed was short time (only 30 minutes) to accept the results confidently.
- The references are sufficient and also, I didn't see any reference which is related to KAP. So, it will be better if articles
 on KAP are added.
- There are also few languages that may not be suitable for scholarly communications. So, it needs editions.

General comments:

- It would be better if the sample size was increased, and comparative study was done between the cases and the noncase communities.
- The manuscript could help the researcher for further study by filling out the gaps identified here.
- Therefore, I recommend accepting the paper, after they have addressed the issues mentioned here and probable by another reviewers.

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
