Some issues need to be addressed: like I said, the paper is a bit redundant, and concepts are repeated many times. I suggest eliminating the repetitive parts (the concept of the relation between human health, animal health, and the environment is repeated in many sections). Secondly, I would add a bit more epidemiology to better understand the actual burden of mosquito-borne diseases in Indonesia and the necessity for a solution.
