

## Review of: "Adoption of Technology Acceptance and Interfaces for Academic Information System Applications"

The topic selected for the research is not modern. There have been numerous papers already published on the issue commencing since 1989. The TAM is a very simple linear model to test the relationship between the variables. The paper would be of good interest if some moderating variables were added to the dimensions. It would make the hypothesis testing more useful. The methodology is simple and used only a t-Test. However, there should be more analysis done applying various other techniques.

The results/findings are similar to those of many other research articles, where PU is usually found significant. The frame diagram is also missing. The total estimated sample size is not mentioned, nor is how the sample size was calculated. This raises questions if 171 respondents seemed to be a representative sample.

I would recommend revising the research design and improving the results/discussion section.

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
