

# Review of: "A Study to Assess the Effect of Pelvic Floor Muscle Strengthening Exercises on Urinary Incontinence in Patients with Cervical Cancer Undergoing Radiation Therapy at a Tertiary Cancer Centre"

The authors have developed a well-executed and well-written study that analyzed the effect of pelvic floor muscle strengthening exercises on urinary incontinence in cervical cancer patients undergoing radiation therapy at a tertiary cancer center.

However, I would like to make a few observations before recommending the publication of your work.

Comment 1. Could the authors add the type of study in the title of their work?

Comment 2. The Discussion section is very complete. However, I consider that there should be a little more discussion on the data presented by the authors, for example when they comment on the level of education of the participants...can you comment on any study that provides results on this? Also, since they have not analyzed whether there were statistically significant differences in their sample according to the level of academic education, I consider that this should be commented on as a limitation of their study.

Comment 3. The study has used sufficient measuring instruments to develop the measurements. However, the use of ultrasonography is missing. This instrument could have shown data on contraction and correlated with the results obtained by the patients.
