I see that there are many reviews already about the research paper.

I would like to ask about how the researchers addressed the issue of sample size error and respondent error. These are missing in the methodology.

Knowledge and attitude are very challenging to measure. Knowledge consists of tacit and explicit knowledge. Which types of knowledge are measured in this research project.

The word "adequate" appears a few times. What is the meaning of adequate as this is a relative concept. See section below.

"Students with adequate environmental knowledge and attitudes should be examined in order to understand their behaviour and how to encourage waste separation and recycling at waste generating sources."

The seminal reference of Fishbein and Ajzen (1980) for Theory of Planned Behaviour are missing.

After addressing the suggestions in my review, I believe that the research article can be published.

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
