

Review of: "Collective Córregos Da Tiririca- Restoration of Riparian Forest in a Stream Contributor of Itaipu Lagoon – Niterói- RJ- Brazil"

The article is interesting and describes syntropic agriculture actions in an area of Brazil with the involvement of the local population. However, mention is made of the restoration of the Atlantic forest, which would be the final stage of ecological succession in this area. Some information should be provided on this type of forest, which now seems to have disappeared, for example, the main tree species. It should be said more clearly whether the aim of environmental restoration is to grow edible species for sustainable agriculture or whether, in the end, we will try to move in the direction of the Atlantic forest, losing a large part of the edible species, and in this case, the consent and involvement of the local population would probably decrease, although areas of high biodiversity would be obtained. There is mention of invasive alien species present, but it is not specified what they are; it would be appropriate to specify this if necessary, also in the species table. It is recommended to italicize the Latin names of the species and to insert the scientific name where it is missing. After these updates and changes, the article is deemed worthy of publication on Qeios. Some more suggestions are in the attached file.
