The study topic is novel, and the findings are insightful. Still, some modifications are needed.

My observations are given below:

The abstract needs revision. It should start with objectives and then move to methods, results, and discussion or conclusions.

The introduction should be concise and to the point. The use of very small paragraphs makes this portion difficult to read. Please improve the study rationale by including theory, research, and practice implications. Please write the study objectives clearly.

In the methods section, add research design, inclusion and exclusion criteria, and study measures. Please relocate the hypotheses to the last part of the introduction.

In the results section, please present the results as per the study objectives in a logical and continuous manner. Please do not put the same information in the text and the tables/figures. Overall, the results are too lengthy, and they need to be reduced significantly.

In the discussion, the interpretations of the results should follow the order of the study objectives. The author should avoid reporting the results in detail here in the discussion rather they should focus on the interpretations of the obtained results. The discussion should generally be started by stating the study objectives followed by the major findings obtained. Then they should be interpreted in light of extant theoretical and empirical findings. Novel findings should be highlighted. Interpretations of the results need significant improvements. Add a subtitle to the conclusion. The conclusion of the study should reflect the obtained results, not their repetitions. Some suggestions/directions for future research and implications for prevention and policy may be added at the end of the discussion. Suggestions for future research and implications should be strictly based on the study findings.

I hope that these suggestions will help the author to improve the manuscript.
