In my opinion, the assessment part that the authors presented is more about discussing the problems or concerns raised with little analysis. When reading the title, I expected more details like discussing from a certain bioethical perspective or theory. It is stated in the abstract and conclusion that "the 'principle of bioethical prudence' should be applied" but the principle is not introduced and discussed in the main text. I think this is necessary before making conclusion and giving recommendation on the best practices.

The abstract should be revised to concisely summarize of the whole article. It should contain the research problem/ research question, objectives, method, findings and conclusion.
