

# Review of: "A Survey Study on Women Entrepreneurship in the BTR Area of Assam"

The paper deals with an important topic, concerning women entrepreneurship. This topic deserves attention and has been explored in recent literature.

It is the first time I review a paper from Qeios, so I am not familiar with the kind of papers published on the Journal. To the best of my knowledge, the paper needs improvements from theoretical and empirical point of view.

From atheoretical point of view, Author(s) could integrate the paper with the wide literature on entrepreneurial orientation in women entrepreneurship. As far as the empirical analysis is concerned, due to the sample of interviewed women entrepreneurs, a descriptive cluster analysis may provide the readers with homogeneous groups of entrepreneurs with similar entrepreneurial profiles. With reference to the entrepreneurial profile, I strongly encourage the Author(s) to read an abundant literature of entrepreneurial orientation and entrepreneurial identity of the entrepreneurs. This could allow to get a clearer description of the identity of women entrepreneurs. Accordingly, with this revision, maybe also policy implications could be discussed more in-depth.
