Good research, but certain errors need to be adjusted.

Below I detail my observations:

Within the introduction, the authors present obsolete literature (it is advisable to base the research with articles no older than 5 years). For example, the authors write: recently, Nisiforou and Charalambides (2012). The authors determine the research problem, but it would need to be supported with recommendations for future research issued by other researchers.

I insist, the authors use very obsolete literature. Example: "A long-term than contemporary ecological perspective can provide a scientifically defensible basis for conservation decisions (Willis et al., 2007"

To improve understanding of the formulation of the hypotheses, it is recommended that they be placed after the literature of each variable (not together).

In the methodology, it is necessary to explain the research approach, scope and research design. It is necessary to justify the selection of the study population. It is necessary to explain where the questions for the interview and survey were obtained.

It is necessary for the authors to further explain the practical and social implications of the research.
