Reviewer Comments

Manuscript section	Description
Title	The title reflects the proposed aim of the study.
Abstract	<ul style="list-style-type: none">It would be better to organize the Abstract as well as the entire manuscript into Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.Also, the keywords should be arranged alphabetically.
Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The full stop should be after the citation, not before it.The introduction is too long and needs a word count reduction.It should be more relevant to the Nigerian experience.The Rationale as well as the aims of the study were not clearly stated.Table (1) should be in the Results Section.
Methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none">There should be a main heading of (Methods).This section needs to be sub-categorized into Research Design, Population Size, and Sampling.Ethical approval of the study was clarified.
Results	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The results should be presented under the main heading (Results).The results are merged with the Methods, and they should be separated.
Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The Discussion was not proportional to the Results. You need to expand the Discussion.
Conclusion	It has been stated in line with the data presented in the current study.
References	They need to be merged with those in the footnotes and written in a unified style.
Overall comments	The study is interesting and explores an important topic.
