A species of aerobic, Gram negative, rod shaped bacteria in the phylum Bacteroidetes.

This bacteria is nonmotile, catalase and oxidase positive, non-fermentative, indole positive, hydrolyzes starch and can grow on cetrinide agar. *C. indologenes* is most commonly found in soil and water and is a rare pathogen, associated with meningitis in neonates and premature infants and nosocomial infections in adults.
