The authors review the literature about EMT in HNSCC, with a focus on clinical implications and therapy.

This review is not ready for publication and should be completely revised or re-written, respectively.

Points of concern:

The structure of the article is somehow similar to experimental manuscripts (e.g., MatMet) and not appropriate for this review, which should only be about experimental results, comparison of results, description of the state of the art, future perspectives, etc. – with a focus on therapeutical implications of EMT on cancer therapy.

Of course, the review should only be based on reviewed journal articles of high quality. This is not special and has not to be discussed in detail.

There is no “story” extracted from numerous relevant publications, with real conclusions or an outlook at the end. Especially in the discussion, it more or less is only a numeration of citations.
